## **Purpose:**

The purpose of this Standard Operating Guideline (SOG) is to outline the position of Brighton Volunteer Ambulance (BVA) regarding Smoking and Vaping.

## Scope:

The scope of this document applies to all Staff.

## **Guideline:**

- 1. Refer to NYS DOH Policy 00-07 No Smoking Policy
- 2. Smoking and Vaping is banned in agency vehicles.
- 3. Smoking is proven to be a health hazard, known to cause cancer and cardio-pulmonary disease.
- 4. Second-hand smoke is also recognized as a health hazard.
- 5. There will be no smoking or vaping within 20 feet of a compressed cylinder (Oxygen, medical air, etc.).
- 6. There will be no smoking or vaping in agency vehicle's, in garages, buildings, or bays.
