16Purpose:

The purpose of this Standard Operating Guideline (SOG) is to outline the position of Brighton Volunteer Ambulance (BVA) regarding specific time metrics.

Scope:

The scope of this document applies to all road personnel. This will cover both MLREMS and agency metrics.

Guideline:

- 1. The agency will follow all Regional Metrics and Care Bundles.
- 2. Agency-specific metrics:
 - 2.1. Chute Time: <two (2) minutes
 - 2.2. Response Time:
 - 2.2.1. P1/2: <ten (10) minutes
 - 2.2.2. P3: <fifteen (15) minutes
 - 2.2.3. P4: <twenty-five (25) minutes
 - 2.3. Scene Time:
 - 2.3.1. Priority Patients: <ten (10) minutes
 - 2.3.2. Non-Priority Patients: <twenty (20) minutes
 - 2.4. Hospital Drop Time:
 - 2.4.1. All occurences: <thirty (30) minutes
 - 2.5. Other Times:
 - 2.5.1. Total Call time: <sixty (60) minutes
 - 2.5.2. Chart Lock time: <one-hundred-eighty (180) minutes

3. In the event that the time standards listed in 2.2-2.2.3, are known to be not possible, Mutual Aid from the closest neighboring agency shall be requested
